I. Policy

Telephones in private residences may not be billed to a University account unless specific permission is granted by the unit head who is responsible for the account and is of higher administrative authority than the requester. The request must include the need for this telephone.

The employee must sign the request, affirming his or her commitment to use it primarily for University business. Charges for personal calls on these telephones fall under the guidelines established in the University of Michigan Standard Practice Guide 512.2.

II. Procedure

Units wishing to provide telephones in private residences must submit a "Request for Telephones in Private Residences" to IT Communications. This request must be signed by the unit head who is responsible for the account and who is of higher administrative authority than the requester. All approvals must be reviewed for continuation or termination by the unit head prior to the beginning of each fiscal year.

Prior to the beginning of each fiscal year, IT Communications will send to the chartfields org manager for each unit a list of persons in that unit previously approved for telephones in private residences. It is the responsibility of the unit head to notify IT Communications of any changes to the list that are necessary.
